Souled Out is a musical ensemble that specializes in the great Motown and Soul sounds. Featuring a three piece vocal section, the group weaves its way through the Motown and 70's soul eras with authentic choreographed dance routines and outstanding musicianship. Not only is Souled Out a sensational listening and dancing experience, it is an awesome visual one as well!

In the 1960's, Motown Records brought about a new wave of Soul music, and many groups emerged from Detroit, U.S.A., to become some of the greatest ever recorded. Making history with their music and their longevity, artists such as the Four Tops, Stevie Wonder and the Temptations soon were established as some of the top Soul artists of that era. The popularity of Detroit's Motown eventually led the way to Philadelphia and a new twist on the classic sound. The Sounds of Philadelphia popularized such groups as the Spinners, the O'Jays and Harold Melvin & The Bluenotes. At last, the 1970's Soul sounds swept the country and brought about a new unique energy and style. Such groups as Earth, Wind & Fire, the Commodores and Tower of Power emerged with full force, bringing funk and attitude to the Soul scene. Today, the hits of all of these great artists have survived the years to become some of the most loved and cherished music of all time!

Inspired by the same definitive musical events, Souled Out brings the adored music of these classic groups to the stage. With impeccable musicality and spirit, the Soul Legends shine through with this stylish and fun show that delivers each performance just like the real thing!

Sounds and moves of Motown and Philly come to Norwell

Souled Out performing two shows in February

A fledgling Detroit record company combined soul, pop and rhythm and blues into one remarkable style in 1959. The result was the Motown sound and an unprecedented string of infectious hits for Motown Records, a streak that stretched from its inception until founder Berry Gordy Jr. sold the company to MCA in 1988. During those years Motown would score 54 No.-1 hits on Billboard's Hot 100.

Motown artists included Smokey Robinson and the Miracles, Stevie Wonder, the Supremes, Marvin Gaye and the Jackson Five. Their songs ("My Girl," "Signed, Sealed and Delivered," "You Can't Hurry Love," "Let's Get It On" and "I Want You Back," to name just a few) are still so well loved that they can be heard frequently on the radio, on television shows, in the movies and on iPods across America. What doesn't happen very frequently is the opportunity to hear this sweet soul music live anymore. Fortunately, we have Souled Out, a band that is dedicated to keeping the Motown sound and its handsome stepchild, the Philly soul sound (the Spinners, The O'Jays, Harold Melvin & The BlueNotes are a few examples), alive.

For the past 10 years they have been touring the eastern United States, re-creating the grooves so many know so well.

Michael Ruscio of Southwick is the lead guitarist and musical director for this large troupe (there are six musicians, three male

singers and one female back-up singer). Although he said he enjoys and playing many types of music, he says he grew up with the great songs from the Motown and Philly soul eras. "I absolutely love this stuff. Each song tells a story and has a meaning. It can make you feel happy or it can make you feel very sad. And it seems to strike a note in everyone's heart that hears it," Ruscio said.

Indeed, in addition to the great songwriting and producing, one of the strongest components of the Motown sound were the incredible session musicians who played on all of the records recorded by the artists at Motown's famed Hitsville, USA recording studio. They were called the Funk Brothers, and they appeared on more No. 1 records than Elvis, the Beatles, and Beach Boys combined. Despite the volume of their

work, these behind-the-scenes players have only recently gotten the recognition they deserved for producing such distinctive and distinguished sounds. While Ruscio is not willing to say that the "Souled Out" musicians are on the same level with the esteemed Funk Brothers, he does say that his guys are good in their own right. Each has a truckload of professional experience and are "heavy hitters" themselves. He says that they go to great lengths to produce "every nuance" from the original recordings.

Out in front of the band, the three male singers re-create not only the vocals, but also the choreographed dance steps of the famous guy groups. (We're sorry fans of the Supremes, Vandellas and Marvelettes – "Souled Out" does not perform the hits of the girl groups.) Together they perform about 25 songs at each show.

The first set is devoted to Motown, the second to Philly soul. Ruscio says his toughest job as musical director is deciding which songs they will play.

"There's never enough time to play all the ones we want to," he said. But, he added, the songs they do play will probably have you up and out of your seat.

"I can just about guarantee it," Ruscio said.
